# PARTICIPATION VERSUS COMMITTMENT




All the contribution checks, golf rounds, smoke-filled card games, steak dinners, and whiskey in the world cannot win when competing against a group that has relationships with its politicians.

Once you establish, and maintain, relationships with your legislators, there is no known defense against this strategy for your industry or profession.






THE JIM HARPER STORY RE: GRASSROOTS





....The Representative DID switch his vote


